List of tools to bring:

- Bone folder and/or a metal folder
- Triangle (ideally with one side 10+ inches long, plus a smaller triangle)
- X-Acto knife (or scalpel) and/or utility knife with snap-off blade
- Ruler
- Tweezers
- Fine pen/pencil for marking
- Lighter or matches
- A bit of sandpaper (very fine grit, approx. 220)
- Glue brush and a glue pot (ie. a small plastic container with lid, something from the recycling is fine!)
- Newsprint or waste paper for gluing
- Cutting mat (self-healing mat or a piece of heavy board 2mm or thicker is also a good work/cutting surface)

In general, bring the hand tools that you are used to using for your bookbinding and paper arts and projects!

Things to bring to if you have them (we can share!):

- Jewelers saw with blades (blades in the range of 000 to 2 are fine)
- 3/8 or 1/2 inch chisel
- Black acrylic paint
- Micro spatula
- Diagonal pliers / wire cutters
